- **Fish Must Be Caught On Rod & Reel According To ODFW Regulations.**
- Tournament Weigh-In Hours 12:00 P.M. to 3:30 P.M.
- All Fish Must Be Checked In By 3:30 P.M. At The Weigh Station At Fisherman's Marine & Outdoor/Delta Park, 1120 N. Hayden Meadows Dr., Portland (NO EXCEPTIONS!!!)
- Tournament Official Is Timekeeper
- Salmon & Steelhead Weights are Combined
- Boats May Have Only 3, 5, or 6 Team Members
- When 2 Teams Fish In One Boat With The Same Captain, The Captain's Score Counts In The Total For Both Teams (Captain Is 3rd Man On Both Teams)
- ODFW Will Be On-Hand At Weigh-In
- Fish Will Be Weighed Whole
- Big Fish Winner Can Only Win On One Team
- Each Angler Must Have A Valid Oregon or Washington Fishing License/Tag
- No Culling Of Fish Allowed
- Teams Can Only Count Legal Fish Caught By Team Members During Hours Of Tournament
- Tournament Fishing Area Includes the Columbia, Willamette, Sandy & Clackamas Rivers.
Note: There Is No Blast Off This Year.
