



23rd Annual Spring Fishing Classic Rules

- 1. Fish must be caught on rod & reel according to ODFW/WDFW regulations.
- 2. Tournament weigh-in hours 2 P.M. to 4:30 P.M.
- 3. All fish must be checked in by 4:30 P.M. at the weigh station at Kleiver Memorial Armory, 10000 SE 33rd Drive, Portland, OR (No exceptions!!!)
- 4. Tournament official is timekeeper, all disputes will be settled at the discretion of tournament official.
- 5. Salmon & steelhead weights are combined
- 6. Boats may have only 3, 5, or 6 team members, all boat occupants must be entered in derby
- 7. When 2 teams fish in one boat with the same captain, the captain's score counts in the total for both teams (Captain is 3rd person on both teams)
- 8. ODFW will be on-hand at weigh-in
- 9. Fish will be weighed whole
- 10. Big fish winner can only win on one team
- 11. Each angler must have a valid Oregon or Washington fishing license/tag
- 12. No culling of fish allowed
- 13. Teams can only count legal fish caught by team members during hours of the tournament
- 14. Tournament fishing area includes the Columbia River and all its tributaries
